Oral presentation guidelines

- Oral sessions are live sessions moderated by a chair person, with chat and Q&A functions for the audience to participate.
- The oral presentations are 6 minutes, which cannot be exceeded. You will have 1 minute for the introduction and 5 minutes for the slides.
- For 6 minutes of presentation, you can prepare maximum 5 slides in PowerPoint, including the introduction and end slide.
- Format for the slide is 16:9.
- Be sure that the PowerPoint slides have the same layout all way through.
- Observe that the content of each slide is not too detailed.
- Avoid showing big tables ('busy slides') and then ask the audience just to concentrate on a small part of the table.
- Prepare the results specific for your presentation.
- Graphs and figures are often better than tables at an oral presentation. Flow charts are very appropriate to describe material.
