## **Prof. Mewa Singh** University of Mysore, Karnataka

Prof. Mewa Singh is an Indian Primatologist, Ethologist, and Conservation Biologist. He is a professor of ecology and animal behavior at Biopsychology Department in University of Mysore. Prof. Singh is a fellow of all the three Science Academies of India: Indian Academy of Sciences, Bangalore; Indian National Science Academy, New Delhi; National Academy of Sciences, Allahabad. He is also a Ramanna Fellow, DST and a Fellow of the National Academy of Psychology, India. To his credits, a new night frog Nyctibatrachus mewasinghi, has been named after him which is endemic to the Western Ghats. It is generally referred to as **Mewa Singh's Night frog**.

Prof. Singh's research focuses on primate social behaviour, including conflict resolution, cooperation, inequity aversion, and food-sharing. He is the author of the book Primate Societies and co-author of Macaque Societies: A Model for the Study of Social Organization. He has published more than 100 research articles on several animal species.
