## Prof. Suraj Unniappan

Prof. S. Unniappan is a Professor at the Department of Veterinary Biomedical Sciences, Western College of Veterinary Medicine (WCVM), University of Saskatchewan. He is also the faculty-in charge of the Endocrine Research Laboratory, a research service core unit of the WCVM. Dr. Unniappan obtained his Ph.D. in Cell Biology and Physiology in 2004 from the University of Alberta, Canada. His laboratory of Integrative Neuroendocrinology focuses on three research themes: (i) neuroendocrine integration of reproduction and metabolism in fish, (ii) endocrine regulation of energy homeostasis in mammals, and (iii) endocrine basis of diseases in humans and domestic animals of commercial importance. Dr. Unniappan is a recipient of several awards including the Zoetis Animal Health Research Award, Pickford Medal in Comparative Endocrinology from the Federation of Endocrinology Societies, inaugural Early Researcher Award from the US Endocrine Society, Bob Boutilier Award from the Canadian Society of Zoologists etc. He is an editor of General and Comparative Endocrinology. He published many research papers in peer-reviewed journals.
